Juried by professional photographers, art educators, and museum curators, selected entrants are granted cash prizes in several categories.

This professional quality exhibition is under the artistic direction of Tanya Braunstein, head of the Santa Rosa High School photography program, and in ongoing collaboration with ArtQuest, Friends of ArtQuest, and the Sonoma County Museum.
